





Proposal 0 illustrates the existing California state marine protected areas (MPAs) in the Marine Life Protection Act (MLPA) North Central Coast Study Region. Proposals 1-3, 2-XA, and 4 were finalized on March 19, 2008 by work teams within the MLPA North Central Coast Regional Stakeholder Group (NCCRS) and are being submitted to the MLPA Blue Ribbon Task Force for consideration.
